- Apply as early as possible; programs with waitlist for September 2011 included:
 - Culinary Arts
 - Practical Nursing
 - Automotive Tech, Carpentry and Woodworking, Communications Engineering Tech, Computer Systems Tech; Civil Tech, Construction Electrician, Heavy Duty Equipment Tech, IMF, IMA, Piping, Power Engineering
 - Many other programs “just” filled
- Application form; original transcript(s); \$50 application fee
- If in doubt about admission requirements, talk to a student advisor first

- 2-day, open-house orientation to the college at the Victoria Avenue East Campus for new students
- Interactive, fun – prizes, games, draws – cookies!
- Runs the week before classes start to enable students to familiarize themselves with their campus
- New students can set up their computer account, get their identity card, buy textbooks, get their locker, etc.
- Shuttle available to and from North Hill Campus
- 59% of expected 1st year students attended in 2011 in Brandon
