# Assiniboine Community College Lieutenant Governor's Silver Medals Nomination Form

This is one of the highest achievements a student can receive from the college. Its purpose is to honour students who are recognized by college staff and other students as having achieved outstanding academic performance and contributed in significant ways to the college and the community.

Students do not apply for this award. Nominations and testimonials for these awards can be made by any combination of three staff and students, of which at least one nominator must be a staff member, and at least one nominator must be a student.

Students must be graduating from a diploma, advanced diploma or certificate program in the 2021-22 academic year. The award will be presented at the relevant June graduation event.

#### Criteria:

#### 1. ACADEMIC AND TECHNICAL ABILITY

- Must have a B (3.0) average or better.
- Where a nominee's technical/practical ability is strong and only one mark is awarded i.e: P/NP, the
  instructor must provide written documentation showing the students technical/practical ability. It
  is also necessary to estimate and indicate the percentage of program load this technical ability
  grade represents (i.e. theory-60%, shop/practice-40%), so that it can be weighted appropriately.

Note: Transcripts are available in Colleague and the Awards Office can access those. Please provide any additional information that attests to the student's academic or technical/practical ability.

#### 2. PARTICIPATION IN COLLEGE AND/OR COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

• List of activities with a short description must be provided. For example, involvement with student council, intramurals, and various other groups and committees; or community groups such as church, Heart Fund, Cancer Society, etc.

### 3. GOOD CHARACTER AND PERSONALITY

Include narrative describing nominee. This category covers such traits as reliability, integrity, being
considerate, enthusiastic, willing, pleasant, motivated, having a positive attitude and good
relationship with peers and instructors, etc.
