



- » Build research skill development into assignments
- » Increase relevance to future student industry
- » Help develop Library collection
- » Apply your subject matter expertise to help spend Library budget on resources for your assignments
- » Reduce avenues for academic misconduct and increase student satisfaction with individualized, researchable topics
- » Compile curated resources



- » Receive customized resources (e.g. videos, handouts) to supplement your course materials
- » Integrate Library staff support and resources, in-person or online
- » Direct students to customized displays in Library
- » Optimize the use of text-matching software
- » Access licensed, digital videos for Moodle and Zoom
- » Align workshops or drop-ins with student spares and work periods
- » Encourage help-seeking behavior in students



- » Supplement scaffolded assignments
- » Facilitate authentic assessments
- » Promote active learning
- » Align with Universal Design for Learning, Anti-Racist Pedagogy, and best practices in academic integrity
- » Empower students with transversal skills such as critical thinking and information literacy



- » Analyze Moodle statistics
- » Align with larger scopes such as curriculum review and program mapping
- » Establish feedback loops for continuous improvement



- » Recognize improvements made to the teaching and learning environment
- » Analyze how improvements helped reduce academic misconduct due to student dissatisfaction
- » Prepare to begin CIEEC cycle again
