

CONFIDENTIALITY

What stays between us and what doesn't.

Privacy is your right to control how your personal information is managed. For information on privacy at Assiniboine, please visit assiniboine.net/privacy.

Confidentiality is an important aspect of advising. I will ensure information is kept between us to the best extent possible. This means the information you share is only shared with other professionals if...

- 1. You tell me you are going to hurt yourself.
- 2. You tell me someone is going to hurt you.
- 3. You tell me you are going to hurt someone.
- 4. There is a medical emergency.
- 5. You tell me something that someone on the ACC team needs to know in order to do their job. The information shared is limited to those people involved due to their roles at the college.

For example; if you disclose that someone threatened your safety, I need to notify officials to make sure the learning environment is safe for you and others, providing only the information required for everyone to do their jobs.

In other words, I only need to share the details of what we talk about if wellbeing (yours, another person's or the college's) is at stake.

I will always do my best to let you know before I share anything we talk about.
